Dear Friends,

At the end of Jesus' life on earth, He gave this charge to His followers:

"I have been given complete authority in heaven and on earth. Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit." Matthew 28:18-19

Unfortunately, many of us are like Arctic rivers: frozen at the mouth. Most of us have missed opportunities to talk about Jesus with our relatives, friends, neighbours and work colleagues because we've 'frozen' on the spot. Clearly, many of us have reservations and fears when it comes to evangelising. The Bible says, 'fearing people is a dangerous trap' (Proverbs 29:25) – and this, for me, sums up our biggest fear in evangelising: other people.

However, we shouldn't be worried about what we do not know, but share what we do know. Jesus taught profound truths in very simple ways. He said, "Unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the Kingdom of heaven" (Matthew 18:3). So it's important for us not to panic, but to be confident about the Good News that we have to offer.

Sometimes, good words can end up feeling like bad words within our culture. The verb to evangelise – which is clearly Biblical, being used 52 times in the New Testament – is looked upon with suspicion today by many people who don't want religion shoved down their throats.

So what does 'evangelism' mean? Evangelism is the practice of sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The word 'Gospel' means Good News. The 'Gospel' to the first century followers of Christ was indeed NEWS – BREAKING NEWS – of 'victory over the enemy' made possible through Jesus Christ. Evangelism is to pass on GOOD NEWS or as my friend Greg Downes says: 'Evangelism means to hand out invitations to a free party that is out of this world.'

I hope that my new training course "Breaking News" will call and inspire people to the work of evangelism; to reaffirm us to spread the Breaking News of Christ, and that we all do so only in the power of the Spirit of God. We are not alone. God has walked the path before us and has sent His Spirit to indwell us and empower us that for the sake of the King and the Kingdom, we may truly know Christ and make Christ known.

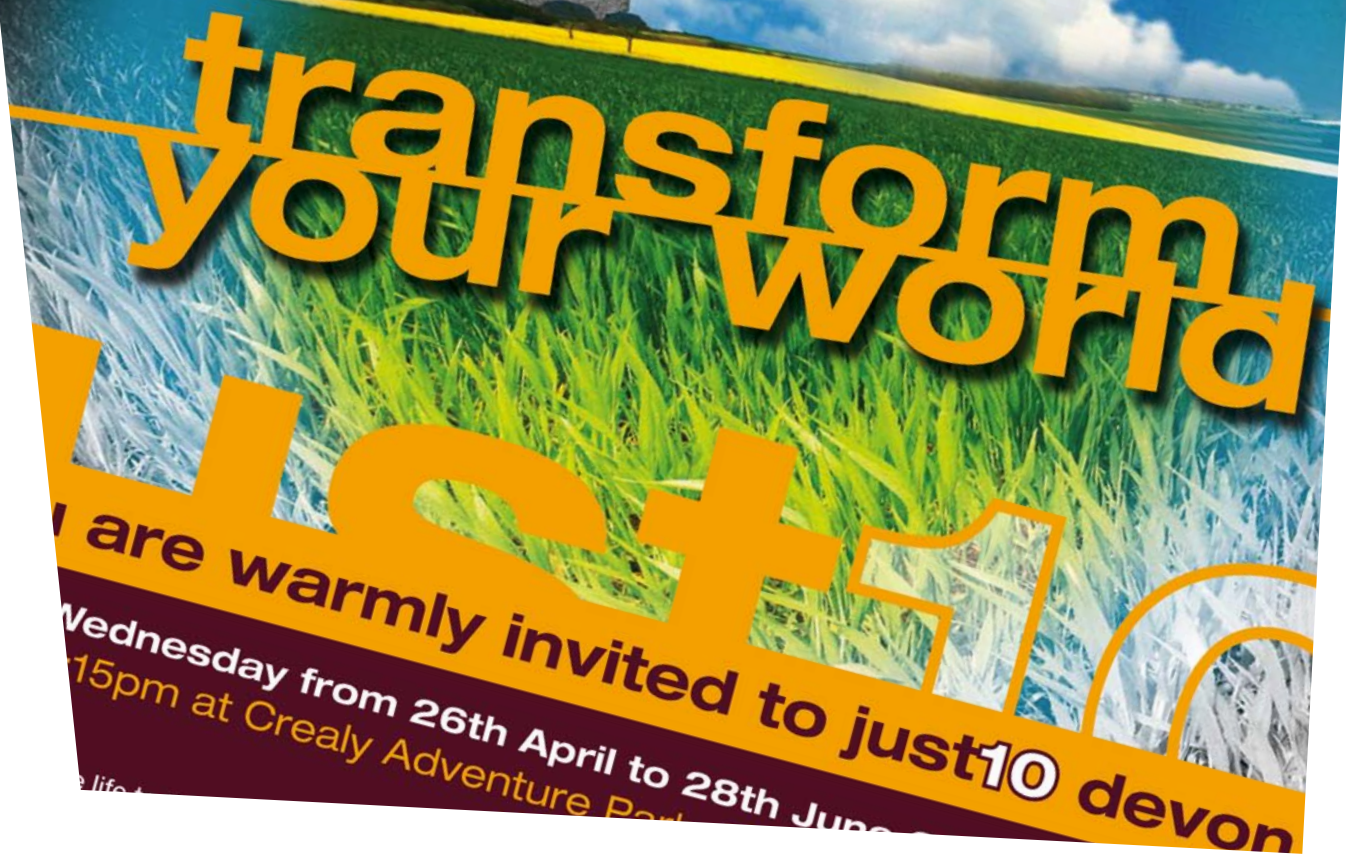

THE COUNTDOWN HAS BEGUN...

Just a few weeks away until the mission series starts in April. The New Year feels like the turning of the bend on the running track and now we are on the home straight. At the time of writing we have 112 partner Churches. There is still much to do but we are on the way and just10 is generating a great deal of interest. The highlight over the past year was September's launch in Exeter Cathedral where 1,500 people from across Devon were present. I think for all who were there it represented a foretaste of what is to come - and importantly what is possible when the wider Church of Jesus Christ unites together for a greater purpose.

A Big Top will be erected in Crealy Adventure Park, near Exeter over the 10 weeks of mission, with the potential for over 4,000 people to come and be a part of just10 Devon and hear J.John. Our hope is that the tent will be full during the ten week series; that many who don't yet know Jesus, people from different walks of life, sections of society, of different ages, and from the spectrum of churches in Devon - would come to be transformed by the timeless message of God's values, and of His grace. And ultimately, that many will come to a living faith in Jesus for the first time.

YOUTH

Every secondary school in Devon has received 'Values for Life' - materials for fresh and exciting lessons based on the Ten Commandments, along with a 'Tough Talk' DVD. Lessons have been specifically put together by the just10 Devon youth team to give pupils the opportunity to explore important life issues from a Christian perspective. (These lesson plans can be found at www.just10devon.org.uk/youth).

Many schools have enthusiastically embraced these courses in RS lessons, PSE lessons, and after school clubs. The three teacher training colleges of Devon (St Marks and St Johns Plymouth, Role College Exmouth, and St Lukes Exeter) are so impressed with the quality of these lesson plans that they are incorporating them into their syllabus. A number of teachers have said they would like to take their class to an evening of just10 Devon in response.

PREPARATION

J.John's evangelism training course has been carried out by the majority of the 112 partner churches, inspiring and equipping the local churches to reach out to their friends. Prayer training

days have been held with John Woolmer to rally together Christians in the spiritual battle that is over Devon, and prayer initiatives have been intensifying coming up to the mission. Prayer cards have been circulating to help young people commit to pray for 3 friends, and a video made to inspire the youth to pray for Devon. A DVD has been distributed around the churches of Devon encouraging Christians to make the most of this season, to reach out to friends and make use of the series to awaken their communities.

south africa

On Thursday 3rd November 2005 J.John, Chris Moffat, Pastor Francis Webster and Hugo Lawrence touched down in Bloemfontein, South Africa to minister at the two largest churches in the nation. We first ministered at Christian Revival Church (CRC) in Bloemfontein. In the past ten years under the leadership of Pastor At Boshoff, the church has grown to 23,000 members.

In addition to meetings with the senior pastors, J.John spoke at the two services on Sunday morning. The musical worship was lead by a passionate choir and band, and it was impossible for one's spirit not to be lifted in worship to God with such a jubilant atmosphere. Many responded to J.John's appeal to commit their lives to Christ and to renew their faith.

Once the second service had concluded, queues of people from the poorest black townships waited outside to receive their weekly food supplies from the church. It was notable that the church was not only very intentional and fruitful in its evangelism, but also had many far-reaching projects to help the poor in their community.

We then flew to Johannesburg where J.John spoke at Rhema Church in the evening. Due to a delay in the small aircraft used J.John arrived 30 minutes late for the service. When we arrived the Church was buzzing with expectancy. Rhema is a church with 38,000 members and has been an influential church in seeing South Africa turn back to Christ. There was uproarious laughter throughout J.John's preaching, mixed with tears and sincere responses to an altar call as J.John spoke powerfully about the message of Jesus.

festival of life

In November 2005, J.John had the privilege to participate in the London Festival of Life at the Excel Conference Centre. 38,000 people attended the gathering to pray for a spiritual awakening in London and the UK. J.John was positively received with a standing ovation when he walked onto the platform. He preached at 10.50pm till 11.30pm when the venue had reached capacity and encouraged every single person to be 'intentional' in reaching others during the Christmas season. They fervently continued to pray till 5am!



carol services

It was as ever a fruitful season over Christmas, with J.John speaking evangelistically at carol services across England. It began in Portsmouth at the Pyramids Centre on 4th December, where a 500 capacity audience (joined by thousands around the world watching on God TV) listened to J.John's message of 'Christmas Unwrapped'. Nicki Rogers, an associate of J.John, brought the message through two beautifully performed songs, while Linvoy Primus, one of Portsmouth FC's footballers, told his story and his encounter with Christ. In the venue alone 70 people responded to commit their lives to Christ, and only God knows how many through their television screens.



J.John subsequently spoke at communitywide Carol Services in Handcross (West Sussex), Southend-on-Sea, Waterlooville, St Helier in Jersey, St Andrews Chorleywood and Hillsong London. Regardless of the different flavours and styles of Christianity expressed at each event, it was a joy to see God drawing many to Himself through all of the tinsel, candlelight, and celebrations.

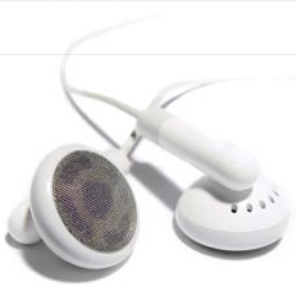


At most of these events, 'It's a Wonderful Life' and 'More Than a Christmas Carol' were given out free as people left, to give people further stimulus to consider Christmas in a new light. Collections were also taken and in total £7,081 was raised for the work of the Naaman Trust among sick children in Iraq and the Middle East which our friend Canon Andrew White administers.



The season ended explosively at the Hillsong London Christmas services on the 18th December. Around 5,700 people came to the 3 services at the Dominion Theatre, with an electrifying atmosphere and an incredible variety of singing and multi-media presentations surrounding J.John's talk. Through it all, 165 people committed their lives to Christ that day.

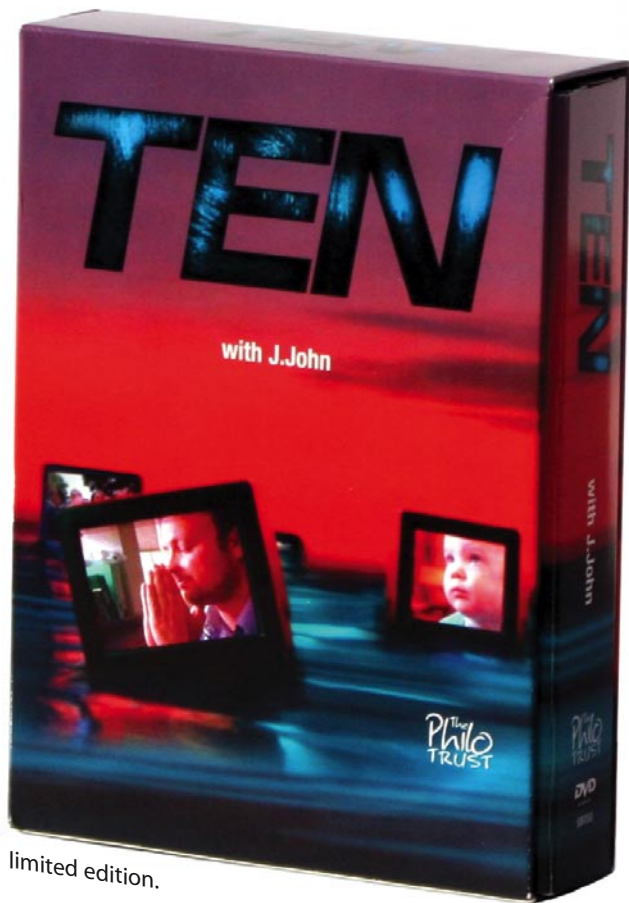

I work as a motivational speaker, author and I coach people on how to develop inspirational and engaging presentations and talks.

I have spoken in 22 countries including North America, Europe, Asia and Africa. I work extensively throughout the UK. I work primarily within a secular context promoting my SUMO (Shut Up, Move On) message. Be assured this is not as aggressive as it may sound and is primarily about our need not to become 'stuck' in the reality of our current circumstances and ways of thinking but to learn how to 'let go' of what hinders us and 'move on' in life (both personally and professionally). This message has also been used within a Christian context and formed the basis of a Church weekend that I lead.

My SUMO message relates specifically to areas such as stress, conflict and dealing positively with change. I enjoy presenting the Christian message particularly within a business context and achieved a degree of credibility when my SUMO book was made WHSmith's business book of the month in June 05.

When I appeared as a contestant on the TV programme 'The Weakest Link' (which I didn't win!), Anne Robinson referred to me as 'Mr Motivator'. In many ways I believe that is my mission on this planet; to motivate and inspire people whatever their background. At the core of the SUMO message is the verse from Romans 12 v 2 '...be transformed by the renewing of your mind'. I want to present people with a new way of thinking that transforms relationships, attitudes and performance both in and outside the Christian context. I try to help people realise that in a sometimes difficult and painful world it is possible to create 'better tomorrows' for ourselves and others and to inspire people to become instigators of this change. Although my SUMO message is not an overtly Christian one, it is based on biblical principles and my hope is that by helping people embrace and apply Godly wisdom, they will ultimately be drawn closer to Jesus, who is the source of my inspiration. I believe my close relationship with J. John and the Philo Trust will be a significant factor in making this happen.
